## Concept

Initial Assessment and management of the seriously injured patient ultimately influences the patient's final outcome. Specifically, knowledge of basic treatment principles of various injuries such as head, chest, abdominal or spinal, can significantly reduce morbidity and mortality of trauma.

## Objectives

The purpose of this course is to orient physicians to the initial assessment and management of the trauma victim. The content and skills are designed to assist physicians in providing the first hour of emergency care for the trauma patient. Upon completion of the course, participants will be able to:

- Demonstrate concepts and principles of patient assessment.
- Establish management policies.
- Initiate primary and secondary management necessary within the first hour of emergency care for life-threatening emergencies.

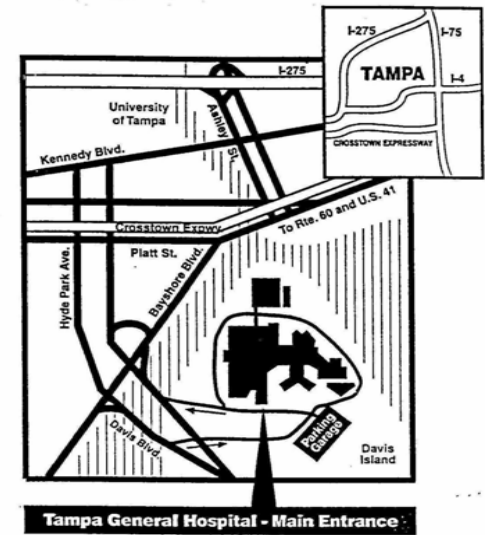
